 And the shapes of the locusts were like unto horses prepared unto battle; and on their heads were as it were crowns like gold, and their faces were as the faces of men.

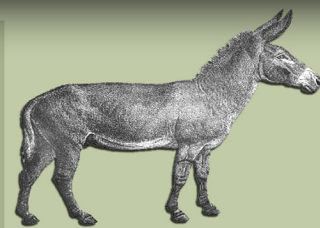
Revelation 9:3

| <p>Birth of Muhammad ibn 'Abdullah in Mecca</p> <p>Birth of Fatimah, daughter of the first wife</p> <p>Muhammad marries the rich widow Khadijah bint Khuwaylid</p> <p>Sept. 622, The Hijra: Muhammad, Abu Bakr and others secretly migrate from Mecca to Yathrib (Medina). This event marks the beginning of the Islamic calendar. Muhammad starts political activities, thus founding the Islamic state.</p> <p>Wedding with 9 year old Aisha, daughter of Abu Bakr. She became Muhammad's favorite wife and the third out of nine.</p> | <p>First Pilgrim's trip to Mecca</p> <p>Battle of Ninive (Cosroes); the "key" of Rev 9:1</p> <p>June 8 Muhammad dies in Medina.</p> <p>Abu Bakr, Muhammads father-in-law, and close companion succeeds to the Prophet's political functions (first caliph). Declaration of Abu Bakr (Rev 9:4)</p> | <p>Schism into Sunni (Muawiya) and Shia (Ali, killed 661)</p> <p>June 8 Muhammad dies in Medina.</p> <p>Abu Bakr, Muhammads father-in-law, and close companion succeeds to the Prophet's political functions (first caliph). Declaration of Abu Bakr (Rev 9:4)</p> | <p>Conquest of the Mediteraian islands by Abbasids</p> <p>Foundation of Ottoman Empire by Osman I.</p> <p>July 27, invasion of Nicomedia (first attack against eastern Rome)</p> <p>The Abbasids caliphate ends with the fall of Bagdad. External unity of the Islamic Kingdom ends</p> <p>The Emirate of Granada becomes vassal state of Castile. Reconquista largely finished</p> <p>October 2, Saladin (ruler over Egypt, Syria, Mesopotamia, Hejaz, and Yemen) reconquers Jerusalem</p> | <p>Aim of the Ottomans: expansion through jihad against territories of countries where the Muslim law is not in force (Dar al-Harb)</p> <p>Sultan Murad II crowns Constantine XI (Jan 6). Beginning of the 6th trumpet and 2nd WOE (Ottomanic Islam) on August 11</p> <p>April 6 - May 29 Mehmed II conquers Constantinople</p> <p>Turkish Mamluks defeated by Turkish Osmands</p> <p>End of the Reconquista with the defeat of the Nasrid dynasty (the last Moors in the Iberian peninsula) in the kingdom of Granada</p> <p>In the year 1840, another remarkable fulfillment of prophecy excited widespread interest. Two years before, Josiah Litch, one of the leading ministers preaching the second advent, published an exposition of Revelation 9, predicting the fall of the Ottoman empire, and specifying not only the year but the very day on which this would take place. According to this exposition, which was purely a matter of calculation on the prophetic periods of Scripture, the Turkish government would surrender its independence on the eleventh day of August, 1840. The prediction was widely published, and thousands watched the course of events with eager interest. (GC88 334.4)</p> <p>At the very time specified, Turkey, through her ambassadors, accepted the protection of the allied powers of Europe, and thus placed herself under the control of Christian nations. The event exactly fulfilled the prediction.</p> <p>When it became known, multitudes were convinced of the correctness of the principles of prophetic interpretation adopted by Miller and his associates, and a wonderful impetus was given to the Advent movement. Men of learning and position united with Miller, both in preaching and publishing his views, and from 1840 to 1844 the work rapidly extended. (GC88 334.5)</p> | <p>Muhammad ibn Abd al-Wahhab commences his missionary work. Wahhabism will base on his teachings</p> <p>Muhamad Ali reconquers Mecca, Medina and Ta'if from the arabian Wahhabis</p> <p>Young Turk Revolution</p> <p>November 1, 1922 Imperial Monarchy of the Ottoman Empire comes to an end. October 29, 1923 it was succeeded by the Republic of Turkey</p> <p>March 3, the Turkish Parliament Abolishes the last (spiritual) Ottoman Caliphate</p> | <p>Sayyid Qutb's Signs Along the Road</p> <p>Becomes Public. He becomes the father of Radical Islamic Movements</p> <p>Establishing of al-Qaeda. August 7, 1998 Bombing of US embassies in Kenya and Tanzania. October 12, 2000 attack against the ship USS Cole</p> <p>Bombing of the WTC, organized by Sheikh Abdel Rahman - the spiritual leader of radical Islam today. He was also behind the November 1997 Luxor massacre</p> <p>Al-Jihad formed in Egypt. A new strategy fo accomplishing jihad is set: invading Europe and the West. October 6, 1981 president Sadat in Egypt shot by the Al-Jihad; but they fail to take over the country</p> |
